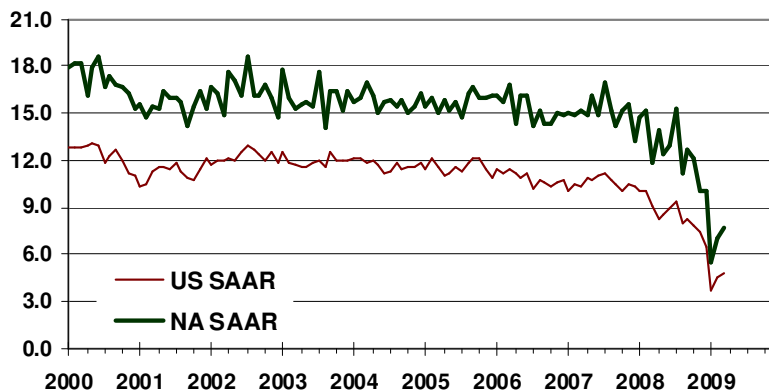

CSM Worldwide, the leading provider of market intelligence and forecasting to the automotive industry, announces the April 2009 CSM Automotive Production Barometer™. Released in advance of existing sources of information, this service provides an accurate record of light vehicle production for the previous month to assist automotive economists and financial analysts in their ongoing industry evaluations.

- US light vehicle continues to improve from January's low, but remains negative, down 54.60% in March at 4.80m units produced on a SAAR basis.
- North American light vehicle production in March 2009 is down 50.80% or 4.15 million units from year ago levels to 7.69 million units produced on a SAAR basis.
- Current production weakness understated due constricted output a year ago from the UAW-American Axle & Manufacturing strike.
- All manufacturers continue to curb local build to deplete excess inventory levels in this deteriorating demand environment for autos.

- Production continues to outpace demand with slowdowns expected through 2Q 2009.
- Market fundamentals remain poor for manufacturers to resume increased build.
- Broad based weakness impacting all manufacturers, Detroit most vulnerable.
- Further market erosion hampering massive inventory correction in process.
